



## Wisconsin National Guard License Plates and Decals Information and Application

### Are you eligible?

Wisconsin National Guard (WNG) plates are issued to any Wisconsin resident who is a current or retired member of the National Guard. The qualified individual must be an owner, lessee or trust beneficiary.

### Vehicles that qualify

WNG plates are available for:

- ▶ An automobile.
- ▶ A motor home (Annual registration only).
- ▶ A private truck, dual purpose motor home or dual purpose farm truck that has a gross weight of 8,000 pounds or less.
- ▶ A farm truck that has a gross weight of 12,000 pounds or less.

**Please note: NO special parking privileges are provided with WNG plates.**

### Things you should know

When you request Wisconsin National Guard plates, you pay:

- ▶ A \$15 issuance fee or the annual \$15 personalized plate fee.
- ▶ An annual registration fee, if your current plates expire within three months.

If a person in possession of WNG plates does not maintain membership in the Nation Guard (except due to retirement), the person must dispose of the plates and apply for standard plates.

The surviving spouse of an active or retired guard member with WNG plates, who is now deceased, may retain the plates.

To legally operate your vehicle, you must display license plates within two business days of purchase. If you do not have current plates, apply to a DMV Customer Service Center or an agent authorized by WisDOT to obtain a temporary plate while your WNG plate application is processed. An agent may charge a plate and/or service fee.

### Personalized plate information

Personalizing your WNG license plates is optional.

- ▶ A \$15 personalized plate fee is required **each** year in addition to the annual registration fee.
- ▶ No refund or adjustment will be made for a change of choice or spacing after the plate has been ordered, or if the application is unclear or incorrectly completed.
- ▶ WisDOT may refuse to issue **or** may recall after issuance, a request that may be offensive to good taste or decency, misleading or conflicts with any other license plate.
- ▶ After the Certificate of Registration is issued, allow 4–6 weeks for the manufacturing and mailing process before the plates arrive.

### Wisconsin National Guard decals

- ▶ A current or former member of the WNG who has or is applying for WNG plates is eligible to purchase one National Guard decal for each set of WNG plates registered in their name.
- ▶ You may choose from one of eight represented units.
- ▶ You will receive one decal to be placed on the rear license plate. Instructions for placement can be found on the back side of the decal.

### How to apply

- To order non-personalized WNG plates, mark first option and go to step 5 below.
- To order personalized WNG plates, mark second option and choose 1–7 characters. If you choose seven characters, you may request up to two spaces between any of the characters. Indicate a space with a diagonal line as shown here.

- Use capital letters or numbers. The letter O and the number zero are the same. The following are not acceptable: small letters, symbols, signs, hyphens, apostrophes, etc. Carefully distinguish between: letters L or I and number 1, letter S and number 5, letter G and number 6, letter Z and number 2, letter B and number 8, letters U and V.
- Provide a meaning for your request, i.e. what does this represent?
- Provide one of the following as verification of membership in the National Guard:
  - » Signature of commanding officer on application.
  - » Wisconsin NGB Form 22.
  - » Federal DD Form 214.
- If the vehicle you wish to register with WNG plates is already titled in your name, send:
  - » A copy of your Certificate of Registration **or** complete the vehicle description on the application.
  - » \$15 issuance or personalized plate fee, plus the annual registration fee if the current plates expire within the next three months.
- If the vehicle is **not** titled in your name, send:
  - » The title assigned to you.
  - » A completed title application: MV1 (Private Sale) or MV11 (Dealer Sale).
  - » All required fees, including annual registration fee.
  - » Additional \$15 issuance or personalized plate fee.
- To order a WNG decal go to page four and indicate your choice.
  - » You may order one decal for each set of WNG plates registered in your name.
  - » Decal fee is \$20.
