ROME HAS FUN FOR EVERY SEASON!

From the two new Sand Valley golf courses to Lake Arrowhead's two elite and challenging 18-holers, you'll soon play a different course every day of the week!

Four-wheeling fun is found at the Dyracuse ATV park, with Motocross/Supercross and Pee Wee tracks, plus over ten miles of trails.

Snowmobilers will enjoy 230 miles of well-groomed trails that weave their way through Rome and Adams County.

Ski jumpers gather at the Tri-Norse Ski Jumps, featuring 5, 10, 22, and 55-meter jumps, and several events scheduled annually.

The Wisconsin Trapshooting Association's facility features 30 trap fields, and hosts the Wisconsin State Shoot each July. The Homegrounds RV Park, within the facility, has 104 pull-through sites with electric/water/sewer.

Fishing enthusiasts, skiers, sail/power boaters, and paddleboarders flock to Rome to take advantage of the foaming fun found on our four lakes. The Shermalot Water Ski Show team performs Memorial Day through Labor Day on Wednesday and Saturday evenings. Talented individuals perform a variety of acts.

The Room To Roam Dog Park of Rome is open all the time, with 9.8 acres for running and playing!

For all your reading needs, visit the Rome Lester Library. Then attend the Friday Rome Farmers Market for locally grown, farm-fresh fruits and vegetables, meats, seafood, bakery, jams, pickles and honey, and plants and flowers, each summer.

Rome is also home to the endangered Kirkland Warbler, Whooping Crane, Clay-Colored Sparrow, and Karner Blue Butterfly, making it a bucket-list destination for nature enthusiasts and birders.
