Rome Police Department Monthly Report October 2015

Meetings/Training Attended

During the month of October I attended Town Board meetings and the Police and Fire Commission meeting. Officers Wilson, Kirslenohr, and Winker continue to attend Emergency Medical Responder Training at Mid- State Technical College.

Calls for Service, Citations, and Written Warnings

In October officers handled 107 calls for service, and issued 36 citations and 3 written warnings.

Department Activities/Announcements

The police department would also like to remind citizens who own seasonal property to please stop in and fill out a vacant home form before leaving their property for an extended period of time. This helps the Police Department to be aware of properties in town that are vacant and gives us accurate contact information for property owners in the event we would need to contact them.

The Police Department held a drug take back event on October 17, 2015 and 20.5 pounds of medication was collected.

Regulatory markers have been removed from the lakes and the patrol boats will be scheduled for winterization soon. In the next two months I will be compiling the boat patrol numbers and completing the paperwork required for the annual audit by the DNR.

Routine Maintenance was done to the fleet during the month of October.

I will be attending required training to keep my Tactical Response Instructor certification and Defense and Arrest Tactic Instructor certification before the end of the year. Interviews will be conducted in the near future for internal candidates that complete and submit application materials for the Sergeant position. The deadline for submissions is November 13, 2015. I anticipate this position will start January 1, 2016.
